WHEREAS, The District is aware of the submission of a Timber Harvest Plan No. 1-17-017-SON ; and

WHEREAS, West Side Union Elementary School is located at 1201 Felta Road, Healdsburg, CA; and

WHEREAS, the proposed route for the logging haul will pass in front of the elementary school on a country road which is narrow with blind curves; and

WHEREAS, school buses and private vehicles drop-off and pick-up students at various times throughout the day; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees and Superintendent/Principal to ensure students' safety at all times;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board hereby urges that a Transportation Impact and Safety Study be required during school hours to ensure that student safety will not be jeopardized by the transport of timber harvested during the implementation of this plan.
